

### EA - Outdoor Learning Service

EA Youth Service provides opportunities for our children and young people to engage in Outdoor Learning opportunities as part of either their school curriculum, or through youth work programmes.

The Outdoor Learning Service also supports the delivery of the Duke of Edinburgh Award for all of EA.

#### **Locations**

The EA offers self-catered / residential accommodation based at: Ballyhome Centre in Antrim and Corrick Centre, in Tyrone. We have two Outdoor Learning Day Centres based at: Epicentre Day Centre with a focus on cycling and use of the outdoor environment to support field studies which are linked to the school curriculum and at Conlig Day Centre: with a focus on cycling and water-based activities and the use of outdoor environments linked to the school curriculum. All of our sites and Centres have undergone refurbishment offering greatly improved facilities.

The EA also offers an experienced Peripatetic Instructor service to all schools or youth groups, either at our Day Centres or at schools/clubs. Our partnership working with Greenhill YMCA and the Corrymeela Community continues; in order to offer extended opportunities to our schools, groups and young people. Outdoor Learning Service also supports the delivery of the Duke of Edinburgh for all of Education Authority.
